

HP INDIGO S2000 FILE GUIDELINE

COMPATIBLE APPLICATIONS:

We have the ability to accept files from the following applications (or earlier versions) in their native format

- > **Adobe CS5 (.ai, .eps, .psd, .indd)**
- > **Corel Draw 11 (.cdr)**
- > **Quark Xpress 6.0 (.qxd)**
- > **Adobe Acrobat (.pdf)**

GRAPHIC ELEMENTS:

- > **FONTS / TEXT** - All fonts should be converted to curves or outlines. Converting fonts will prevent a font substitution and lessen the chances of printing with the wrong font. Include fonts if the file has large areas of text.
- > **BLACK OBJECTS** are to be a blend of 60% Cyan, 40% Magenta, 40% Yellow and 100% black.
- > **BITMAP** (photographic) images should be no less than 300PPI **at actual size**. If the quality of the bitmap is poor, the quality of the final output will be poor.
- > **IF BITMAP IMAGES** are embedded and are not included as support files it may result in undesirable reproduction
- > **SCALE** of file to be actual size
- > **SUPPLY FILE AS 1 UP**. If multiple images are to be ganged up on a sheet, step up 1/4" between crop marks and make sure there is at least .125" bleed on the graphic if necessary. (Crop marks to be no smaller than .0625" in length and no larger than .5"). If the file doesn't need any bleed, step and repeat butted up against one another. (see pg.2)
- > **MAXIMUM IMAGE AREA: 11.6" X 17.2"** - crop marks and/or bleed to be inside these dimensions. (see pg. 3)
- > no outlines to be less than .25pts
- > no unnecessary elements in the file, (*don't cover up elements with white boxes - delete them or mask them*)

VARIABLE DATA FILES

If you require variable data please show this on your printout or give us clear detailed instruction on where the variable data should be placed. All **variable text** data can be supplied to us as a text file, an Excel .csv document, or clearly written. All **variable images** should be saved separately as **.TIF, .EPS or .JPG**

SUPPORT FILES (Bitmaps):

- > **.EPS** (save Photoshop .eps with "JPEG maximum quality" encoding)
- > **.JPG** (saved with highest quality setting)
- > **.TIF** (saved with LZW compression)

COLOUR:

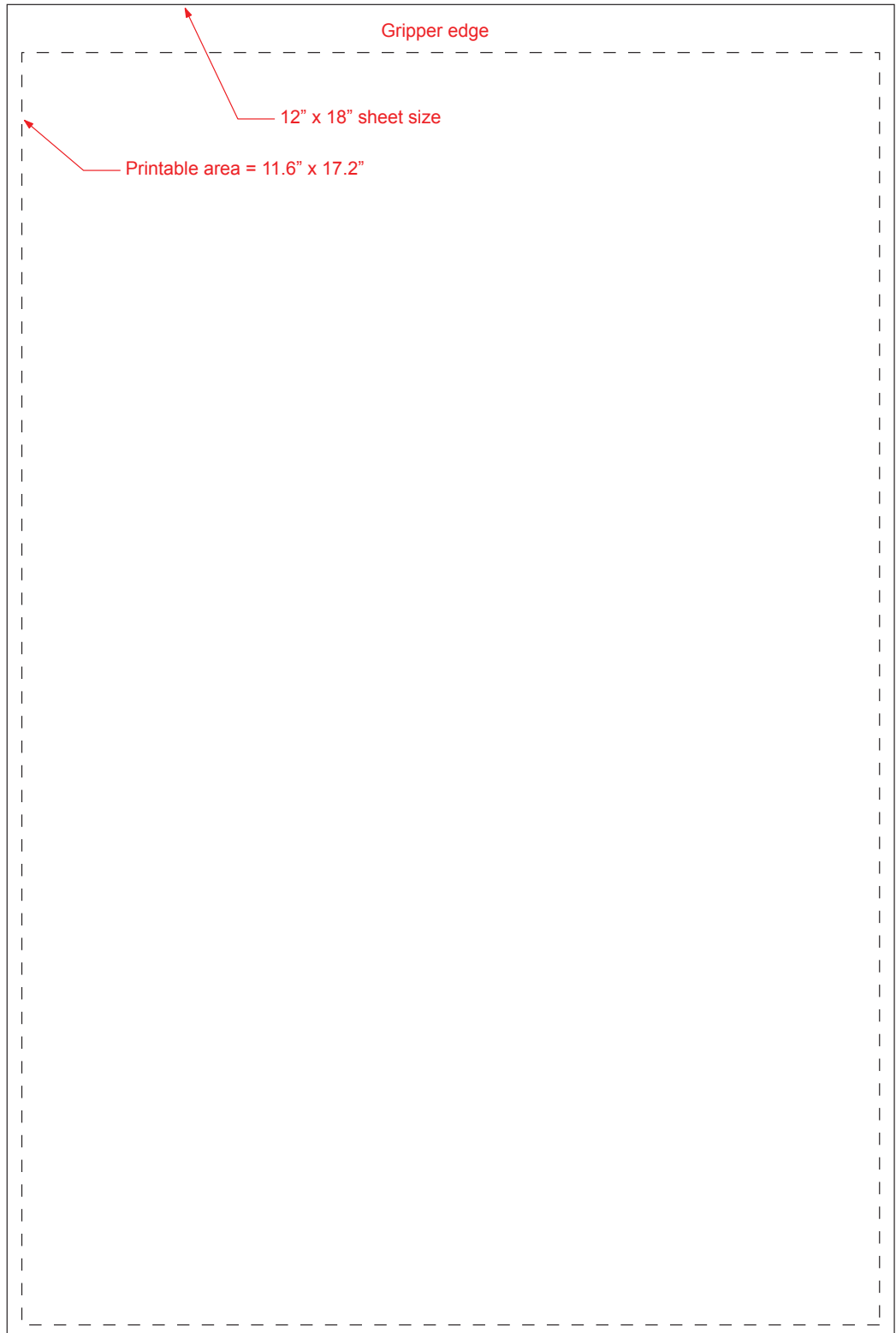
- > It is important to understand that digital presses automatically convert Pantone & RGB colours to CMYK
- > Files supplied to us must be in the CMYK colour space
- > A CMYK composite quality printout, original photos and/or PMS colours must also be supplied in order for us to match your desired colours

- > Please call your account rep for FTP-USER-ID and password or see our website
- > Compressing your files may make file transfer easier and will lessen the likelihood of file corruption (.zip, .sit, .rar)
